
In Experiential learning students learn to take initiative, make decisions, and be accountable for the results. Students engage intellectually, creatively, emotionally, socially, or physically.



The students are provided experiential learning by arranging study tours. These tours are useful to enrich the knowledge and understanding of the subjects in a fruitful way.





Faculty using ICT tools in a session






Debate Competition






